Study abstract

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Title: aspects to be taken into consideration when it come to develop Arabic language curriculums within King Abdullah Bin Abdulaziz Project For Developing Public Education and its connectivity to teachers and supervisors' point of view in such concern.

Study objectives:

- Identifying developmental activities seeking for enhancing Arabic language curriculums within King Abdullah Bin Abdulaziz Project For Developing Public Education.
- Identifying teachers' point of view that may help developing Arabic language curriculums.
- Identifying supervisors' point of view that may help developing Arabic language curriculums.
- Identifying the relation between officials in charge of king Abdullah project view and teachers & supervisors view.

Study results:

The study came to the hereinafter conclusion:

- Making a list that covered aspects for developing Arabic language curriculums. Relevant list was classified into eight axes , they are :

*Content , teaching reading skills , teaching writing skills (calligraphy & dictation) , methods to teach grammar , methods to assess literature works , lingual contact , Arabic language activities , methods of developing the language .*Meanwhile, there is also a card as well that incorporated ten questions concerned with methods on how to develop Arabic language curriculums.

- the most significant attainable results concerned with developing Arabic language curriculums within king Abdullah project ,are like what follows hereinafter:

a- Development initiatives: such initiatives to develop Arabic language curriculums is represented in employing technical methods ,creating an integrated image for the curriculum ,that is besides some indicative instructions that aims for enhancing learning efficiency .

b- Interview with officials –in charge and its results: On interviewing with officials –in charge, we didn't get to any significant view for developmental activities and methods to change project's strategies right after transferring it into education holding corporation.

- The most significant results concerned with teachers' view concerning developing Arabic language are like what follows hereinafter:

Most of aspects concerned with developing Arabic language that were covered within such study were of great importance per teachers own view since the eight axes of questionnaire got "Important level " with arithmetic average of (,) & (,)

- The most significant results concerned with supervisors' view concerning "Developing Arabic Language", are like what follows hereinafter:

Most of aspects concerned with developing Arabic language that were covered within such study were of great importance for teachers since the eight axes of questionnaire got "*very important level*" except for "lingual content aspect that got "*important level*" while arithmetic average was (,) and (,)

- The relationship between the Arabic language curriculum developing project efforts and the supervisors and teachers views to advise some teachers limited to develop Arabic language subject learning and to use technical tools easily.

Recommendations:

- Setting clear vision concerning matters attached with developing educational curriculums in general ,and Arabic language curriculums onto king Abdullah project for developing education .
 - Great care to be taken for developing Arabic language's curriculums within KSA with great employing of project's credentials and chances .
 - Getting use of teachers and supervisors' views and proposed suggestions concerning developing Arabic language curriculums.
 - Getting use of researches, surveys, projects and studies that deal with "developing Arabic language curriculums topics."
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
